

Heinemann Scherzinger Batzenberg Spätburgunder 2022

Full bottle 1,309 g. Vines, clone 777, are 40 years old. 35 hl/ha. Spontaneous fermentation in an open stainless-steel fermenter. 80% whole bunch. Aged for 20 months in French barriques two to five years old. Unfiltered. RS 1.5 g/l.

Much darker than the Oelberg. Sweet and crisp. Well etched with punch and potential. Not yet anywhere near peak. Long and focussed. Though certainly not juicy!
